LONDRA, 19. — L'« Agenzia Reuter » ha da Washington: Le rivendicazioni americane in Turchia per i beni requisiti o distrutti dai turchi durante la guerra sono state regolate con un accordo approvato dai due Governi, in base al quale la Turchia pagherà la somma globale di 1.300.000 dollari.

Turkey and the United States.

Following negotiations conducted by the Turkish and the United States Governments, Turkey has agreed to pay a sum of 1,300,000 dollars to the United States of America in payment of losses sustained by American citizens during the War, as provided for by the agreement signed at Lausanne on December 24, 1923. This payment will be effected in thirteen annuities of 100,000 dollars each, beginning from June 1, 1936.

In commenting on this arrangement, the Turkish Press expresses the wish that it may supply evidence of Turkey's determination to keep to all her financial engagements, even though they originated prior to the establishment of the new régime.
